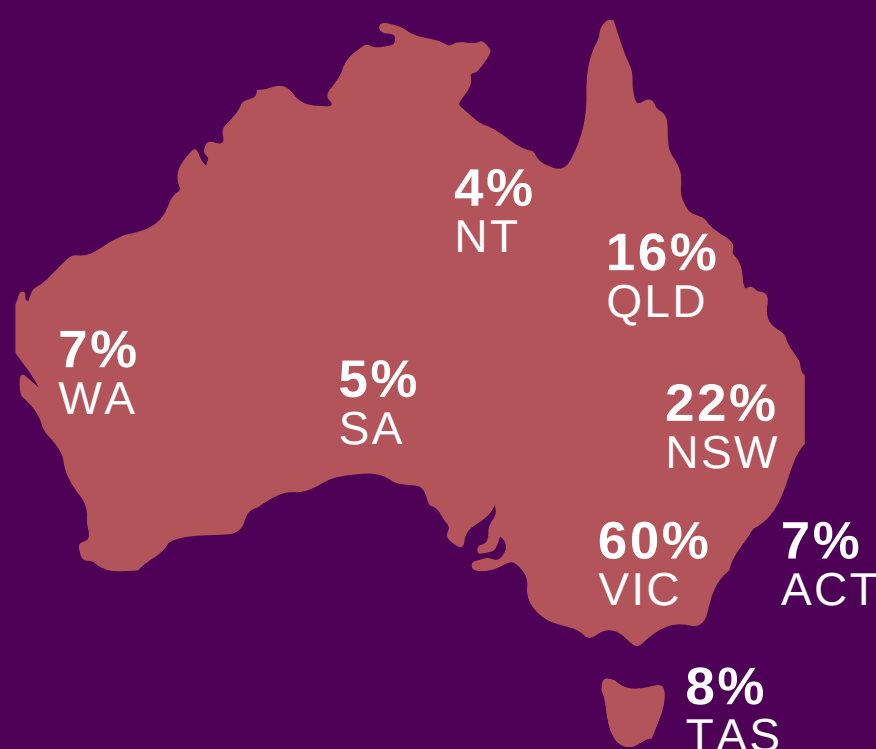


## Training needs in aged care

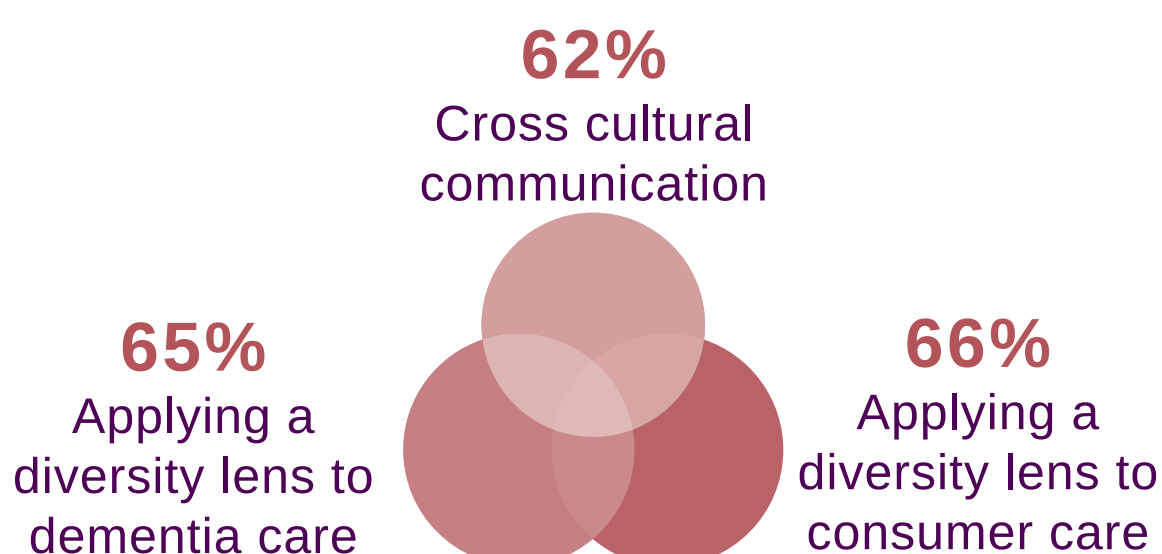
We asked aged care providers from across Australia about the training and resources they need to support consumers and carers from culturally diverse backgrounds. Here's what they had to say.
